### **COVID** Prevention 22 - 23

We are still living with COVID and likely will for a very long time. It is still a highly transmissible illness. Here is what students and families can expect on campus.

- All staff and students are required to be fully vaccinated and up to date on boosters. Vaccination greatly reduces the severity of illness.
- Masks are optional, but we strongly encourage all staff and students to mask indoors. Teachers may request that all students wear masks while in their classroom. Students should come to school prepared. We will also have masks in each classroom.
- Please keep rapid tests on hand at home and test your child if they have symptoms. If a student exhibits symptoms of COVID 19, we will test the student at school when given parent permission.
- If greater than 10% of the school population tests positive for COVID within the same 14-day period, masks will be required indoors until the spread has ended.
- Families will be informed of any positive cases at the school.



Admin are busy planning for the new school year. Here are a few things to look forward to:


